Dear Parent/Guardian:

The Baltimore County Public Schools (BCPS) will continue using the One-card identification system for all students, teachers, and staff in accordance with Superintendent's Rule 3710: *Identification Badges*. The One-card identification system is a tool for improving safety and security for students, teachers, and staff and for student accountability. It identifies BCPS students, teachers, and staff and is also used for checking out library materials and for documenting attendance at the schools who are piloting ScholarChip.

All students are issued a One-card, a card case holder, and a safety lanyard. Middle and high school students are responsible for wearing their cards on a daily basis and taking them home at the end of each day.

Like textbooks, One-cards are the property of BCPS. If a student loses or misplaces his or her One-card, a permanent replacement card will be issued for a fee of \$5. If the student does not have the replacement fee at the time the replacement card is provided, an obligation for the replacement amount of \$5 will be issued. Students who do not bring their One-cards to school will be charged \$1 for a temporary replacement card for that day only. All obligations should be settled quarterly.

The use of the One-card is not optional. All students are required to wear their One-card at all times unless there is a safety concern such as during recess and physical education class. Please remind your child to wear their identification cards daily.
